SATURDAY EVENING PRAISE SERVICE AT FIRST UMC-CC LIVES UP TO EXPECTATION.

The air was charged with excitement from the moment Joseph Abston struck the first chord on the piano to begin the Saturday evening Praise Service on Feb. 13 at FUMC. A near capacity crowd rocked the chapel as they sang songs of praise and thanksgiving. The Sacrament of Holy Communion was served at this first service and will be offered on the first Saturday of each month here after. May persons lingered in the chapel parlor for coffee and cookies afterward. A service of this type is marked by its informal and spontaneous atmosphere so it is hard to restrict it to a 60 minute limit. The dynamic of praise is more that of a leisurely conversation with the Spirit than the precise brevity of an inter office memo. Henceforth, the service will begin with singing at 5:20 PM. By doing this we would expect to be able to close the service nearer to 6:30. If you or someone you know needs a spiritual lift, we recommend you try the Saturday Evening Praise Service at FUMC, CC.
