The community is the only family these men will have to hold a candle for them.

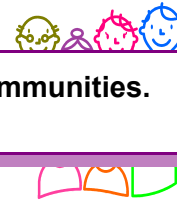
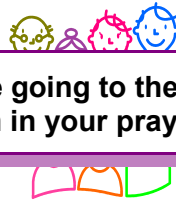
**DIRECTIONS to ZEPHYR from CC:** Take IH 37 North, exit 34 for Mathis / Alice. Turn left on Hwy 359. Go straight through Mathis and Sandia. A couple of miles outside of Sandia there will be a blinking yellow light, turn right on FM 534. Stay on 534 for 12 miles and then take a right on FM 3162. Camp Zephyr is 3 miles down on the right. Drive through to the designated area ( by the cafeteria), park and come to the Tabernacle building. There will be signs posted with directions at the site.

**DIRECTIONS to ZEPHYR from Calallen:** Take FM 624 to Orange Grove to the 4 way stop, turn right on Hwy. 359. Go about 4 miles to the blinking yellow light, turn left on FM 534. Stay on 534 for 12 miles and then turn right on FM 3162. Camp Zephyr is 3 miles down on the right. Drive through to the designated area (by the cafeteria), park and come to the Tabernacle building. There will be signs posted with directions at the site.

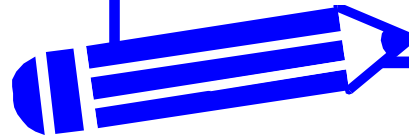
