**MAY ZEPHYR WALK NEEDS OUR SUPPORT**

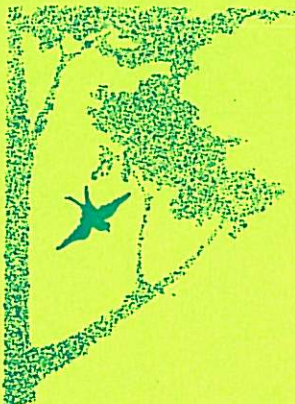
