The Walk to Emmaus is a three-day immersive experience offered by the local Coastal Bend Emmaus Community. The inspiration comes from the Gospel of Luke, Chapter 24, in which after His resurrection, Jesus walked with his two followers who did not fully recognize Him.

The CB Emmaus Community has a Women's Walk scheduled for Nov. 10-13. During the three days, you'll hear 15 talks based on personal testimonies of others who have made the Walk before you. Each talk, worship service, and retreat event offers you another opportunity to grow closer to Christ on your own personal Walk with Him. Your participation in all aspects of the Walk would be voluntary; you won't be asked to give a testimony yourself.

Although Walks offer spiritual renewal, they are not necessarily restful. You'll need to adhere to the Walk schedule throughout the weekend.

Apart from not being "in this world" for the three days, you have the blessing of carrying no responsibilities as you experience the peace and unconditional agape love of Christ, as presented by a team of dedicated Christians serving as His hands and feet.
